

This is an overview of your child's sixth term in Reception.

Throughout this term, we will be continuing to recap the phase 2 and phase 3 sounds.

Please continue to support your child with their reading at home, focusing on recognising and reading the tricky words on sight to help develop their fluency.

We will also be continuing to work on our independent writing, encouraging the children to write the sounds that they can hear in words. Please support this at home by giving your child different opportunities to practise their writing. Please also encourage your child to use finger spaces after each word and a full stop at the end of their sentence.

During this term your child will be continuing to practise solving addition and subtraction number sentences. Please support this at home by writing your child some simple number sentences (7+4=/8-2=) to solve using objects to help them.

We will also be continuing to look at sharing and how to share equally. You could support this at home by encouraging your child to share a set of objects between two or three

We will also be continuing to look at doubling and halving and will practise this by using
