Vísits from Dental Technicians

On 20th June, we had two separate educational visits from dental practitioners. In Early Years and KS1, the children enjoyed learning all about how to look after their teeth. They were shown how to brush their teeth correctly and now know that they need to brush in a circular motion for 2 minutes. They also spoke about different foods and learnt which ones were good for their teeth. and which ones were bad.





There was a buzz of excitement as our LKS2 children came into school with their toothbrushes ready for the Dentistry visitors. The children learnt how to brush their teeth, including cleaning their tongue and cheeks whilst brushing and practised this on the giant teeth model. Each child was given their own travel size toothbrush and toothpaste to take home.
